

Cow



The head

- Cast on 14 stitches in WHITE.
- Row 1; K2TOG, K10, K2TOG (12 st.)
- Rows 2-6; stocking stitch (first row is a purl row)
- Row 7; knit 1, make 1 stitch by picking up the loop between stitches, then knit 2. Repeat this to the end of the row, then knit 1 (making 18 stitches).
- Rows 8-12 stocking stitch
- Row 13; Knit 2 together across all stitches (making 9 stitches)
- Row 14; purl
- Row 15; [K1, K2TOG] and repeat until the end of the row (6 stitches).
- Cast off

The ears (make 2)

- Cast on 3 stitches in BLACK
- Row 1; knit
- Row 2; K1, inc, K1 (4 st)
- Rows 3 & 4: Knit
- Row 5: K1, inc, K2 (5st)
- Rows 6 & 7: Knit
- Row 8: K2, inc, K2 (6st)
- Rows 9 - 13: Knit
- Row 14: K2tog, K2, K2tog (4st)
- Cast off

The body

- Cast on 28 stitches in WHITE
- Rows 1-2; rib {K1, P1}
- Rows 3-4; stocking stitch

- Rows 5-16 stocking stitch. In these rows you make the black 'cow' spots. These are by definition irregular and a-symmetric, so you can use any design. This is not very difficult, just cut off 20-30 cm tails of BLACK yarn and use one for each spot.
- Row 17; knit
- Row 18; P2TOG across all stitches (making 14 stitches)
- Row 19; K2TOG across all stitches (making 7 stitches)
- Row 20; P2TOG across all stitches (making 4 stitches)
- B&T

Making up

- Sew up the head, filling it as you proceed.
- Attach the ears tot the head and embroider the eyes



- Sew up the body and attach the head
- Crochet a chain of about 2 cm length with double yarn.
- Attach the tail
