

# Piano



There are two ways of making the piano design: you can knit in two colours (fair isle style) or add it later

The hat patterns are different as will. The hat on the left is really easy to make, no increasing or decreasing. The hat on the right is the basic hat pattern.

## The hat on the left

- Cast on 28 st. in WHITE
- Rows 1 - 2 rib
- Rows 3 - 8 stocking stitch
- Rows 9 - 13 piano design (start from the bottom) in stocking stitch or continue in WHITE only
- Change to BLACK
- Rows 14 – 16 stocking stitch
- Rows 17 – 18 rib
- Cast off
- Close sides
- Weave in tails

## The hat on the right

- Cast on 28 st. in WHITE
- Rows 1 - 2 rib
- Rows 3 - 4 stocking stitch
- Rows 5 – 9 piano design (start from the bottom) in stocking stitch, or continue in WHITE only
- Rows 10 – 14 stocking stitch in BLACK only.
- Row 15 [P2, P2TOG] and repeat till the end of the row (21 st.)
- Row 16 knit
- Row 17 [P2TOG, P1] and repeat till the end of the row (14 st.)
- Row 18 knit
- Row 19 [P2TOG] and repeat till the end of the row (7 st.)
- Row 20 knit
- B & T
- Add the piano stripes (if applicable)
- Join row ends
- Weave in tails
- Add a pompon if you like
